Dear Colleague,

Following the one-off garden waste collections carried out over the last two months of 2021, we are planning a further interim collection starting in January 2022. This has followed discussions about restoring the collection in full with Tunbridge Wells Borough Council and Urbaser.

As before, the service will start with those households whose bins are normally emptied on a Monday. It will also start in Tunbridge Wells with their 'Monday' collections first, before moving to our 'Monday' collections, and so on. The reason the order remains the same is so those bins collected longest ago are collected first.

Subscriptions in Tonbridge and Malling will remain suspended so there is no charge to residents until the service is reinstated in full.

We are doing all we can to restore regular collections as soon as possible, and will let you know as soon as the situation changes.
