(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MARCH 2023

To allow white lining works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Rochester Road, Burham.

A closure is planned from 20th March 2023 at 20:00, with estimated completion by 21st March 2023 at 05:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40112405840-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Rochester Road will be closed between the junctions with Bull Road and New Cout Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while white lining works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Pilgrims Way, Rochester Road, Chatham Road, A229 Blue Bell Hill, Lord Lees Roundabout, Bridgewood Roundabout, B2097 Rochester Road, B2097 Maidstone Road, Priestfields, Borstal Street, Wouldham Road, High Street, Hall Road, Village Road, New Court Road, Court Road, New Court Road & vice versa.
